

NEIGHBORHOOD SEWER REHABILITATION: NORTHEAST AREA & GOOSENECK CREEK NORTH

WHAT WORK WAS DONE?

This project rehabilitated and/or replaced approximately:

- 74,000 linear feet of sewer mains
- 1,050 service lateral connections
- 75 manholes

WHO DID THE WORK?

KC Water was assisted by its program manager, Burns & McDonnell; its design professional, Lamp Rynearson; and its construction contractor, Kissick Construction.

WHAT'S THE "CONSENT DECREE"?

In 2010, the City of Kansas City, Missouri entered into a federal Consent Decree with the United States Environmental Protection Agency to reduce the volume of overflows from the City's sewer system. KC Water's Smart Sewer program is a 30-year effort to address this challenge. The Northeast Area and Gooseneck Creek North Neighborhood Sewer Rehabilitation Project was one of more than 100 projects being implemented by the Smart Sewer program, and was required by the Consent Decree to be completed by December 31, 2020.
