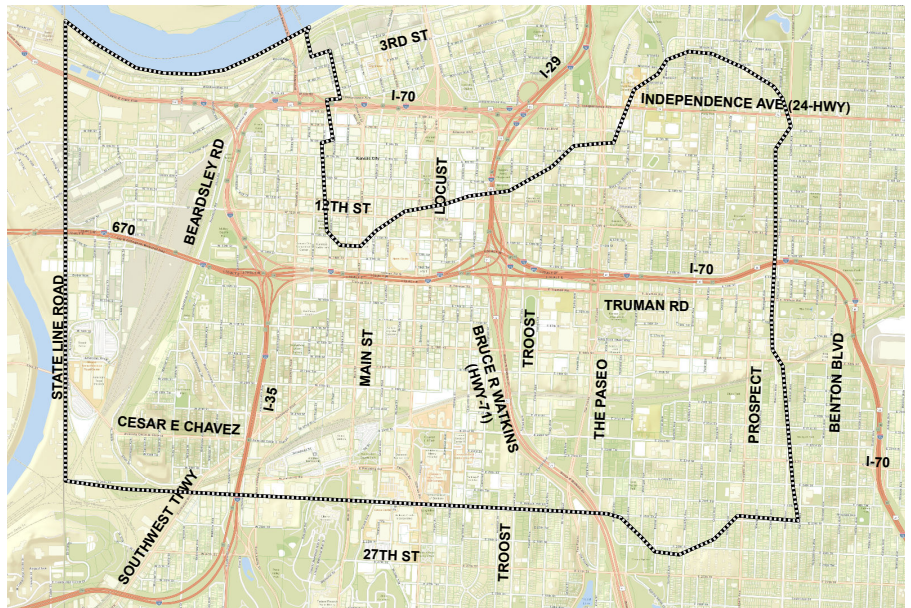
CONSTRUCTION COMPLETED: **JANUARY 2021**
TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT: **\$9,600,000**

KC Water constructed important improvements to the wastewater system in your neighborhood. This project rehabilitated sewer mains, service laterals, and manholes in your area to like-new conditions. Now complete, the project has restored capacity to the wastewater collection system as well as reduced the volume of sewer overflows and potential for basement backups.

NEIGHBORHOOD SEWER REHAB: TURKEY CREEK & CENTRAL INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AREA 1

WHAT WORK WAS DONE?

This project rehabilitated and/or replaced approximately:

- 31,784 linear feet of sewer mains
- 218 service lateral connections
- 157 manholes

WHO DID THE WORK?

KC Water was assisted by its program manager, Burns & McDonnell; its design professional, Black & Veach; and its construction contractor, Leath & Sons, Inc.

WHAT'S THE "CONSENT DECREE"?

In 2010, the City of Kansas City, Missouri entered into a federal Consent Decree with the United States Environmental Protection Agency to reduce the volume of overflows from the City's sewer system. KC Water's Smart Sewer program is a 30-year effort to address this challenge. The Turkey Creek and Central Industrial District Area 1 Neighborhood Sewer Rehabilitation Project was one of more than 100 projects being implemented by the Smart Sewer program, and was required by the Consent Decree to be completed by March 30, 2021.
